Gas Co. Refund Plan Approved

California Public Utilities Commission has ordered the Southern California Gas Co. to begin refunding nearly \$10 million to customers in its service area. The commission approved the refund plan worked out by the gas company.

More than \$6 million of the refund will go to residential and other firm customers, the gas company reported. The average residential refund is estimated at \$3.

The refund is the result of excessive charges for out-of-state gas. The Federal Power Commission ordered the El Paso Natural Gas Co. to refund the excessive amount collected during the period April 15, 1955, to December 31, 1957.

Junipers Will Answer Many Problems of Landscaping

By almost any standard, junipers are a fabulous family of plants. They grow high, low, and in-between, fulfilling a variety of needs that make our gardens easier to look at and easier to care for.

As ground covers, the dwarf junipers have few rivals, thriving on unfriendly soil and with little or no attention. They are excellent foundation shrubs, too, and are equally good at lining a walk or filling in a rock garden vacancy. You can even plant them in tubs or other containers to add greenery to decks and patios.

THE LARGE shrubby junipers are substantial plants for wide borders, where they cover considerable space and blend well with other evergreen subjects. The California Assn. of Nurserymen finds them the best of all conifers for border use. These shrubby junipers also make good ground covers, albeit taller covers than the more frequently used creeping varieties. The taller, more upright junipers are wonderful for accent — against a wall of the house or a fence. Some of them are columnar and formal. Others, such as the Hollywood Twisted Juniper are informally dramatic and full of unrestrained beauty. Junipers don't bloom, but as you see from the above, they do everything else you might ask for. Let's look at some of the more popular forms available in C.A.N. nurseries. A **RELATIVE** newcomer among the prostrate members of the family is the Wilton Carpet Juniper, which almost literally makes a carpet of foliage on banks and/or level areas such as parkways. The foliage is a silvery-blue-green, which helps to make it a real winner in the nursery trade.
