Garden Checklist

1. Water dahlias thoroughly at about five-day intervals. Feed now with complete fertilizer, keeping it away from the main stalks.

2. Shade trees may be planted now from containers. Summer planting gives you the advantage of a full years growth over planting next year.

3. Chrysanthemums have few pests, but aphis show up on occasion. They should be controlled before they get a foothold. See your nurseryman.

4. Various selective controls are available for crab grass. You can apply them this month.

5. Pinch chrysanthemum plants back for the last time. After this, let them grow on undisturbed except for removing excess side buds.
