During the special session which followed our regular meeting earlier this year, the Senate adopted a resolution calling for an interim study of the "financial problems arising out of California's continuing growth of population, inflation, and expanding state responsibilities . . . "This resolution bilities . . . This resolution was assigned for study to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee, under which the Legislative Analyst operates. lative Analyst operates.

THE ANALYST'S brief re port brings up to date trend data which his office had previously prepared and made available to individual lawmakers and legislative committees and also presents significant new material. It points out that the apparent intention of the resolution is to develop trends resolution is to develop trends in state expenditures as they relate to a) growth in population; b) inflation, or price changes; and c) "expanding state responsibilities," which might be defined as including all expansions in authorizations. all expansions in authorizations for state functions and pro-grams.

The report shows that total fiscal-year expenditures of California state government leaped 862 per cent from 1946 to the current year, from \$342 million to \$3.3 billion. During that same period, our total popula-tion has increased only 90 per cent, from 9.4 million persons to almost 18 million. The dramatic impact of this enormous increase in state spending is only too evident in the per capita figures, which eliminate the effect of population growth. In
