

TUBERCULOSIS IS unique in the nature of its reservoir. Most of these 32 million infected persons were exposed to the germs, developed the infec-tion, and their bodies healed the lesions without any aware-



It is hoped that these two five-year programs will establish a picture of the long range trends in infection levels and provide a measure of the success of existing efforts in tuberculosis control. The data collected will also help spot the communities where special emphasis will be required. ERADICATION IS still a long way from achievement, but on the basis of the steps that have already provided greater and greater control of tuber culosis, professional health workers are now starting to think and plan with the goal of eradication of the disease in mind. Some day, penhaps, the dream will become a reality.
