ORDINANCE NO. 1446
AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE, REPEALING SECTION 11.6 OF "THE CODE OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE 1954" RELATING TO THE PLATOON SYSTEM OF THE FIRE DEPARTMENT, ESTABLISHING NEW PROVISIONS THEREFOR RELATING TO THE SAME SUBJECT MATTER, AND DECLARING THE PRESENCE OF AN EMERGENCY.

The City Council of the City of Torrance does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1.
That Section 11.6 of "The Code of the City of Torrance, 1954" is hereby repealed in its entirety.

SECTION 2.
Section 11.6 is hereby added to Chapter 11 of "The Code of the City of Torrance, 1954" to read in its entirety as follows:

"Section 11.6. Division into three bodies or platoons; hours of duty; etc.

The officers and members of the fire department shall be divided into three bodies or platoons. The hours of each platoon shall be from 8:00 a.m. until 8:00 a.m. of the following day. The arrangement of working shifts shall be made by the chief of the department in such a manner that each shall work three shifts during every period of nine consecutive calendar days and in addition thereto nine shifts during each calendar year at such times as shall be directed by the chief, allowing each fireman such shifts off as may be necessary. This leave shall be construed as leave from the station only, and officers and members on such leave shall be considered on duty and subject to orders in case of need. No officer or member of the department shall be permitted to go off duty on such leave during an emergency."

SECTION 3.
That the City Council hereby declares this ordinance to be an urgency measure, the immediate adoption and passage of which is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and the proper functioning of City Government, for the reason that the program of the Fire Department into three bodies or platoons must go into effect January 1, 1964, to enable said department to operate efficiently after said date.

SECTION 4.
This three-platoon program shall become effective January 1, 1964.

SECTION 5.
Any provision of the Torrance City Code, or appendices thereto, inconsistent herewith, to the extent of such inconsistencies and no further, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 6.
This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force immediately after the passage and adoption thereof, and the City Clerk will certify to the passage and adoption of this ordinance and shall cause the same to be published once in the Torrance Herald, a semi-weekly newspaper of general circulation, published and circulated in the City of Torrance. Introduced and approved this 19th day of December, 1963.

ORDINANCE NO. 1444
AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE, ADDING ARTICLE III TO CHAPTER 26 OF "THE CODE OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE 1954" TO REGULATE THE DIVISION OF LOTS OTHER THAN SUBDIVISIONS AND THE DIVISION OF LOTS BY SUBDIVISIONS; AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 1410 WHICH SET FORTH THE SAME REGULATIONS AND DECLARED THE PRESENCE OF AN EMERGENCY.

The City Council of the City of Torrance does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1.
That Article III is hereby added to Chapter 26 of "The Code of the City of Torrance 1954" to read in its entirety as follows:

"Article III. Rules of Applicability. Sec. 26.100. Lots divisible by five. Any lot to be used for residential purposes which can be divided into five or more lots in accordance with the provisions of the subdivision map act of the city (Appendix I of this Code) or which lot is 24,000 square feet or more in area must be divided as a subdivision in accordance with the provisions of article I of this chapter 26 rather than as a lot split in accordance with the provisions of article II of this chapter 26."

SECTION 2.
That Ordinance No. 1410 entitled "AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE, ADDING ARTICLE III TO CHAPTER 26 OF 'THE CODE OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE, 1954' TO REGULATE THE DIVISION OF LOTS OTHER THAN SUBDIVISIONS AND THE DIVISION OF LOTS BY SUBDIVISIONS AND DECLARING THE PRESENCE OF AN EMERGENCY" is hereby repealed in its entirety.

SECTION 3.
Any provisions of the Torrance City Code, or appendices thereto, inconsistent herewith, to the extent of such inconsistencies and no further, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4.
This ordinance shall take effect after the date of its adoption and prior to the expiration thereof shall be published at least once in the Torrance Herald, a newspaper of general circulation, published and circulated in the City of Torrance. Introduced and approved this 19th day of December, 1963.
