Officers and directors of the chapter also will be installed at the Jan. 6 meeting. Don Galvin, president of the Far Western District for the national organization, will officiate.

## West Basin's Sea Barrier Bids Opened

United Geophysical Corp. of Pasadena is the apparent low bidder to construct another unit of the west coast sea barrier project in Redondo Beach, Supervisor Burton W. Chace reported yesterday.

The firm's proposal of \$189,008.56 was low among three offers received by County Flood Control District Chief Engineer M. E. Salsbury. Bids ran to a high of \$408,479.

Known as Unit 4B of the barrier project, the job involves drilling 26 observation wells to check on effectiveness of the program, Chace declared.

District engineers will examine all bids and recommend award of contract by the Board of Supervisors in about 10 days.

CHACE SAID the wells will be situated along Prospect Avenue between Torrance Boulevard and Pacific Coast Highway and at various locations along Ronald Avenue, Onyx Street, Marialinda Street, Irena Avenue, Garnet Street, Camino Real, Ruby Street, Via Los Altos, and Sharrynne Lane. Bids on 13 additional observation wells were opened Friday, at 11 a.m. in Sals-

bury's office for another phase of the program, Chace said.

This portion of the work, known as Unit 1C, is expected to cost \$90,000. The wells will be located within the dedicated rights-of-way of South Prospect Avenue between Anita Street and Vincent Avenue, with another in Del Amo Street near Prospect, in Redondo Beach.

Supervisor Chace said the barrier program will provide an effective barrier preventing sea water from infiltrating valuable water sources along the coastal area from Playa del Rey to the Palos Verdes Hills.

## Business Machines Class Set

College level courses in adding machines, calculating machines, and bookkeeping machines will be offered next semester at Harbor College, Robert Wrenn, chairman of the business division, has announced.

The introductory courses in office machines will cover instruction in the operation of the full-key and 10-key boards. Special emphasis will be put on speed and accuracy, according to Wrenn.

The college business division also will offer courses in the use of calculating machines. Application of the fundamentals of addition, subtraction, multiplication, division and related arithmetical problems will be covered.

Applications for admission to the college next semester will be accepted until Jan. 24, 1964. All persons planning to attend spring classes must apply to the Admissions Office at the college.
