

Public Notice

Notice is hereby given that sealed bids will be received at the office of the Chief Engineer of the Los Angeles County Flood Control District, Room 105, 2250 Alcazar Street, Los Angeles, California, on Friday, March 6, 1964, and will be publicly opened and read in Room 111 of the same building for the CONTRACT NO. 8703, DRAIN BOND ISSUE PROJECT NO. 540, UNIT 2 SOUTH TORRANCE, LINE 4 AND A PORTION OF LINE 16, IN UNINCORPORATED TERRITORY OF THE COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES AND IN THE CITY OF TORRANCE, CALIFORNIA.

The work under this project is covered by two alternate proposals, each proposal covers the entire project and the two proposals differ only in that Proposal 1 is predominantly pipe construction while the Proposal 2 is predominantly box construction. Bids may be submitted on one or both proposals.

Proposal 1 involves the construction of approximately 165 linear feet of reinforced concrete box culvert in size from 6'-0" WIDE by 4'-0" HIGH to 5'-0" WIDE by 4'-0" HIGH; 11,577 linear feet of mainline reinforced concrete pipe varying in size from 12 inches to 30 inches in diameter; 4,844 linear feet of reinforced and non-reinforced concrete connector pipe varying in size from 36 inches to 15 inches in diameter; and appurtenant work.

Proposal 2 involves the construction of approximately 2,587 linear feet of reinforced concrete box culvert in size from 6'-0" WIDE by 10'-5" HIGH to 5'-0" WIDE by 7'-0" HIGH; 11,577 linear feet of mainline reinforced concrete pipe varying in size from 12 inches to 30 inches in diameter; 4,844 linear feet of reinforced and non-reinforced concrete connector pipe varying in size from 36 inches to 15 inches in diameter; and appurtenant work.

Bids must be accompanied by a certified or cashier's check or bidder's bond in an amount equal to ten (10) percent of the amount of the bid. Payment to Los Angeles County Flood Control District as a guarantee for the bidder's performance on the contract, to be paid in full upon payment within fifteen (15) days after the date of the award and furnish a bond in the amount of at least fifty (50) percent of the amount of the bid.

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Los Angeles has determined the prevailing rate of per diem wages in dollars, based on working day of eight hours, for each craft or type of workman or mechanic employed in the construction of public works.

Except as otherwise specifically provided for painter classifications, the rates of per diem wages for each of the various classifications of work shall be for the time specified in the contract, to be paid in full upon payment of the appropriate purchase price for the drawings and specifications.
