Watson warned that fallure to answer all questions can result in denial of the claim.

"Failure to fill in all blanks or to sign the form means an incomplete and unacceptable

Any incomplete forms will be held in the main office. The be held in the main office. The veteran will be notified and he must appear in person within 10 days to complete the claim or he will forfeit the exemption.

Any veteran who does not receive an exemption claim

receive an exemption claim form by Friday and whose service record is on file with the assessor may receive a form on request by contacting the Hall of Administration, 500 W. Temple St., MA 5-3611.
