The Warhoop received excellent ratings in each of the

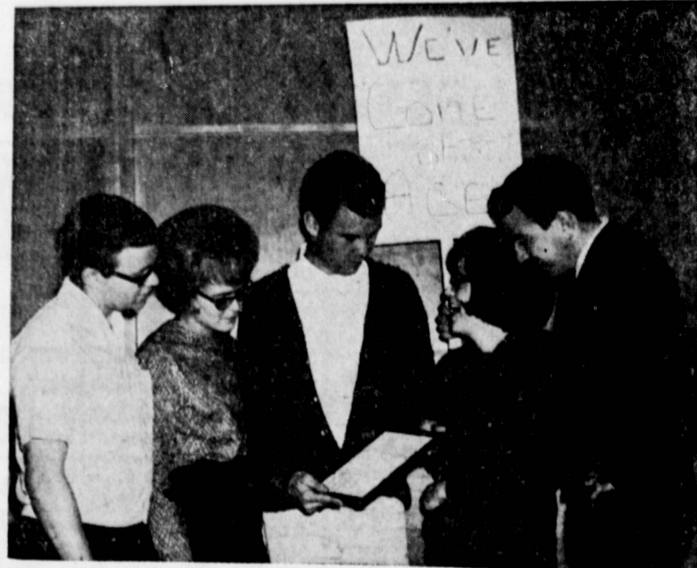
three divisions: coverage, content, and physical properties.
