of unvaccinated dogs (and cats) remain in every community, a source of potential danger.

By way of additional protection against the spread of rabies, the importation, trapping, or capture of skunks, squirrels, chipmunks and other small wild animals for sale as pets is prohibited by law.

country is so heavily infected with rabies that eradication of the disease among them is practically impossible. Therefore the best safeguard against the disease is to keep away from them. Wild creatures normally avoid human contact. Those that can be caught are probably ill and should never be handled.

California law requires that animal bites be reported to local health authorities so that the animal may be picked up and kept in confinement for a

period long enough to determine whether the animal is rabid. And, needless to say, all animal bites should receive prompt medical attention. Whenever possible, the animal should be caught, not killed, and confined for observation or laboratory examination. Otherwise, the victim may have to submit needlessly to painful and prolonged antirabies treatment.
