Unemployment Federal Aid Now Resumed

The State Department of Employment resumed payment of unemployment insurance benefits to former civilian employees of the federal government and to former members of the armed forces Monday, according to an announcement from the department in Sacramento.

Approximately 15,000 Californians were receiving unemployment insurance when benefit payments were suspended due to lack of funds March 19.

Unemployment benefit payments under the California state unemployment insurance law were not interrupted by the suspension of benefits under the federal laws.

Resumption of payment followed the announcement that President Lyndon B. Johnson signed a supplemental appropriations bill which makes \$42 million available nationally for payment of benefits for the remainder of the fiscal year which will end June 30, 1964.

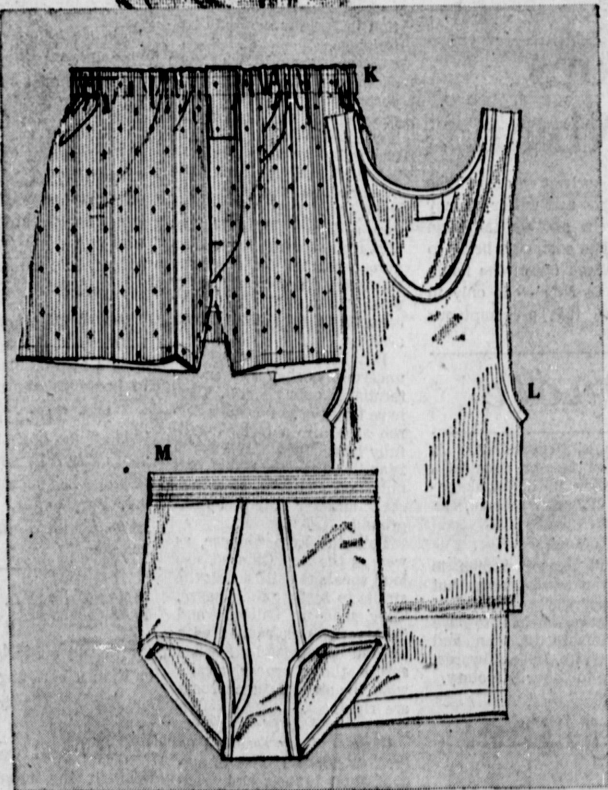
