Street Work Under Way in Carson Area

More than three miles of Figueroa Street in the Dominguez area will be upgraded and improved under a contract awarded by the Board of Supervisors.

Work on the section, between Torrance and Lomita boulevards, got under way Monday. The project involves the resurfacing of southbound lanes and the patching of northbound lanes.

The project also calls for the painting of signal standards at seven intersections, and new striping on the roadway. The entire section will remain open to traffic during the work.
