WASC Committee Visits South High for Report

The process of accrediting South High School moved a step closer to reality this week when a five-man committee from the Western Assn. of Schools and Colleges (WASC) visited the campus for interviews with students, teachers, and other personnel.

Dr. John Winnery, superintendent of the Montebello School District, heads the committee which will make a recommendation on South High School to the WASC board.

Other committee members include: Dr. Wallace Jones, consultant for the division of secondary education of Los Angeles County; Donald L. Madson, principal of Glendora High School; William McCreary, chief of the bureau of guidance from the State Department of Education, and Dr. Erwin M. Keithley, assistant dean of the school of business at the University of California.

The committee received a bound book containing the results of eight months of self-appraisal by more than 1,000 administrators, teachers, students, and classified personnel at the school. The five-man committee completed its appraisal yesterday.

South High is seeking a full

five-year term from WASC. The association accredits all school and colleges in the western states through the same evaluation methods. Both North and Torrance high schools completed reports in 1962 and 1963 and received the full-term approval.

Members of the Tars and Spars, honor service groups on campus will head discussion

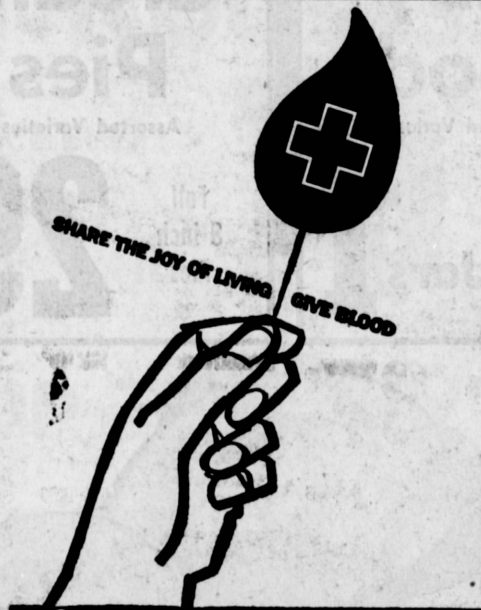
