State Statutes Of Limitations In Many Books

Several people have asked me how they can obtain the "Statute of Frauds" and the "Statute of Limitations," apparently because the word "Statute of Limitations" are in a sense misleading because they suggest that the laws on these subjects are found in some single, compact statute, neatly bound and easily available if a person can only find where to get them. Such is not the case.

The basic provisions relating to the "Statute of Frauds" can be summarized briefly by stating that certain contracts, to be enforceable, must be in writing and signed by the contracting parties.

IN CALIFORNIA there is no single, separate "Statute of Frauds." The California law on this subject is found in certain sections of the California Civil Code and also in the California Code of Civil Procedure.

However, even if a person read these sections in two entirely separate California Codes (law books), he would still find himself in trouble unless he also read the court decisions on the same subject. Then, having read the court decisions, he would have to decide how the California laws and court decisions pertained to his own problem. This means that a layman involved in a problem pertaining to the so-called "Statute of Frauds" should retain a lawyer.

THERE ARE actually many "statutes of limitations," that is, laws requiring that an action (beginning of court trial) be brought within a particular period of time if it is to be brought at all. Since there are "statutes of limitations" pertaining both to criminal and civil cases, the California laws on this subject are found in the California Code of Civil Procedure and in the California Penal Code.

In addition to the two California Codes mentioned, there are "statutes of limitations" scattered throughout many other California Codes. Furthermore, reading the California statutes is not enough because many court decisions must be studied to arrive at a conclusion of any value. This is another example of the necessity of retaining a lawyer.

I am not a lawyer and the above comments are not presented to create business for lawyers. I emphasize the importance of retaining a lawyer when a person has legal problems because if a lawyer is retained soon enough, he may give his client advice which will avoid trouble. Unfortunately, most people do not retain a lawyer until they are so deep in legal problems that the best lawyer on earth may not be able to save them from their difficulties.

A GOOD ANALOGY exists in the field of medicine and surgery. I believe that it is good sense to go to a Doctor of Medicine at least once a year for a very thorough physical examination, even if you are in excellent health, because the doctor may discover that you have a tendency toward some very serious ailment or injury which which can be avoided by diet, exercise, or comparatively simple medication.

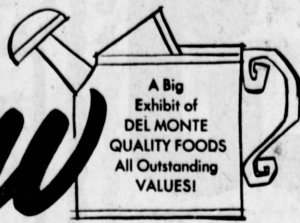
Returning to lawyers, anyone starting a new business is wise to consult a lawyer to avoid making mistakes which would be costly eventually. The old trite, hackneyed proverb: "An ounce of prevention is worth a pound of cure."

The above statements about the "Statute of Frauds" and "Statute of Limitations" are based upon a written, official opinion of the Legislative Counsel of the State of California. Normally, I would quote the opinion verbatim but it includes so many references to law books, court cases, and other publications supporting his opinion that I find it simpler to summarize the official opinion.
