Stop, Turn Signs Slated On Crenshaw

New stopping and turning regulations on Crenshaw Boulevard north of Redondo Beach Boulevard have been approved by county supervisors.

Signs will be posted requiring southbound traffic on Crenshaw in the far right lane to turn right at Redondo Beach Boulevard. In addition, stopping will be prohibited on the east side of Crenshaw for 225 feet north of Redondo Beach Boulevard.

"These restrictions are in conjunction with the construction of a left-turn pocket by the County Road Department on the Crenshaw Boulevard north approach," according to Supervisor Kenneth Hahn.

He pointed out Crenshaw and Redondo Beach boulevards together carry a daily traffic flow of 44,000 vehicles through their intersection.
