The subject came up when trustee William Hanson asked that the board go on record with a policy statement that it would adjust the budget each year to make the recently voted tax increase last the full five years.

After several minutes of discussion, in which more than one board member admitted he was "completely confused," the motion was amended to read, "the board is on record that it will not ask for an additional tax override during the next five years."

The amended motion passed unanimously, for, as one board member put, "how can you vote against it?"
