

EC Eyes Metro Net Crown

Undefeated in 22 junior college matches, the El Camino College tennis team has been installed as a heavy favorite to win the Metropolitan Conference championships, which open a two-day run at Valley College tomorrow.

The Warriors, whose only loss was a one-point non-conference setback to California State at Los Angeles, won the conference dual meet crown with a perfect 14-0 record and over the past weekend swept to jaycee honors in both singles and doubles play at the 65th renewal of the Ojai Tennis Tournament.

In the singles finals, Ehlers, a freshman from Mira Costa, won the tournament championships in singles, defeating teammate, Jaime Collaco for the crown. Then the terrific Warrior two-some bounced back to win the doubles title.

In the singles finals, Ehlers defeated Collaco, 6-4, 6-3, while Ehlers and Collaco downed Mickey Allison and Jim Bacon of San Diego, 7-5, 9-7, for the doubles championship.

Ehlers and Collaco were the only two El Camino entrants in the junior collegiate division.

City-Wide Spike Meet Set May 9

Registration will close Saturday at 5 p.m. for the first annual city-wide track meet for elementary school boys to be sponsored by the Torrance Recreation Department.

To be eligible, boys must be 10 years old or over and still be in elementary school. The meet will be held May 9 at North High School.

All boys will be placed in one of four divisions, according to age, weight and height. All boys will be limited to competition in two events.

Bigger elementary school youths may compete in the 100, 180, 440, a shuttle relay, the long jump, the softball jump and reach.

Younger boys may compete in the 50, 100, the 200-yard shuttle relay, the standing long jump, the softball throw for distance and the jump and reach.

Registration blanks are available from any of the following elementary school playgrounds: Arlington, Flavian, Hickory, Hillside, Jefferson, Madrona, Lincoln, Newton, Parkway, Perry, Riviera, Seaside, Sepulveda and Victor.

Blanks are also available at El Retiro, Walteria, Torrance, McMaster, La Romeria, Paradise and El Nido parks.

The second annual El Camino Kiwanis Club Boys and Girls Relay Swim Meet will be held Sunday at El Camino College.

More than 15 teams from Los Angeles and Orange counties will be represented. Over 1700 entries have already been received. Contestants will range from 10 years and under through 17 years.

At last year's meet, four national records and seven Pacific AAU standards were broken.

Admission to the meet will be 75 cents for adults and 40 cents for children 12 years old and under.

Tribe in Metro Spike Finals

Many of California's top jaycee track representatives will match speed and muscle at the Metropolitan Conference championships Saturday at Bakersfield College.

Coach George Ker's powerful Valley Monarchs, dual champions with a 7-0 record,

are expected to win a lion's share of the honors but could be pressed by any one of three teams — Cerritos (6-1), Bakersfield (4-3) and East Los Angeles (5-2).

El Camino, who finished in a fifth place tie with San Diego at 2-5, may garner enough points to finish among

the top three although a higher placement is unlikely.

The Warriors boast individual talents in distance man Wes Rizor, who ran a 4:15.2 anchor mile leg in El Camino's winning distance medley relay team at the Mt. San Antonio Relays, Pat Pagett, a 14 ft. 6 in. pole vaulter, Dan Dye, a

consistent 51-foot shot putter, and Mike Parson, a 1:55.1 half-miler.

However, El Camino lacks the depth to rate much of a challenge to Valley, Cerritos and Bakersfield, the teams expected to finish 1-2-3.
