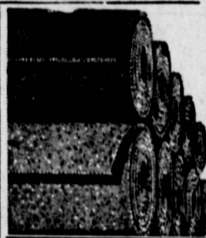

The three-day festival will feature an art exhibit, symphony and ballet performance, drama and youth concert. There is no charge for admission. The art exhibit will open Friday, at 3:30 p.m., at the auditorium. The chosen works of the area's most prominent artists will be on display throughout the festival.

The symphony Friday, at 8 p.m., will feature composer and concert-pianist Paul Stoye. A resident of Palos Verdes, Stoye is well-known throughout Europe and the United States.
