Coaches Request Tabled For Study With Budget

A move to end compensatory time off for coaches in the Torrance high schools was tabled by the Board of Education this week until further studies on the budget are completed.

The Coaches Assn. and Dr. Robert Morton, assistant superintendent for personnel, had recommended paying coaches an extra \$375 for each sport and assigning each coach a full academic load.

North High basketball coach

Keith "Skip" Enger said the move would give about \$20,000 each year since a full academic load for each district coach would reduce the load on other teachers.

"I want to congratulate the administration," said trustee Albert Charles, "they have presented a new expense and a savings at the same time." Charles said the new arrangement, if approved, would actually increase the out-of-pocket expenses of the district.

A savings on the move could be effected by retaining the present teacher load. Such a move would effectively elimi-

nate about seven teacher positions in the high schools, thus producing a net savings of about \$20,000.

Several board members voiced concern that such a move for the coaches would result in similar requests from other teachers with extra duties, such as debate or music teachers.

Enger said only Torrance, Palos Verdes, and Beverly Hills now use the compensatory time off system. All other area districts give the coaches extra pay for each sport, and coaches are limited to two sports.

The item was tabled on motion of Charles until further study of the budget is completed by the trustees.

Measles Top List

Measles took the lead with three cases in the Torrance area for the week ending April 25, according to the Los Angeles County Health Department. Other reportable illnesses recorded included: gonorrhea, two cases; hepatitis, two; scarlet fever, one; syphilis, one; and tuberculosis, one.

Montgomery Debators Win Top Honors

Debate students at Bishop Montgomery High School won top awards in the recent speech tournament held at St. John Vianney High School.

Montgomery's Dan Rothwell and Bill Schneider defeated Plus X and West High, then overpowered St. Anthony's of Long Beach in the finals to win the top debate award at the invitational tournament.

Of the 18 teams, representing seven high schools, Montgomery's team scored 83 of the possible 100 points and claimed a superior rating from the judges.
