Proceeds from the dance will be used to support the association's scholarships. Admission is \$2 per person.

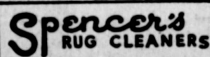

**Professor Miller Joins Mickey Mouse Club Soon**

Walt Disney's Mickey Mouse Club will assume "color" in living black and white this fall and viewers won't even require a special television set to get the effect.

As a substitute for special equipment and film, Disney has added "color" with the signing of Professor Julius Sumner Miller to a one-year contract beginning this fall.

Miller, internationally famous physics instructor from El Camino College, will assume the television role of Professor Wonderful as his Fun With Science series makes its debut.

MILLER isn't new to television. His remarkable and dynamic approach to the teaching and demonstration of physics is known worldwide through his own series and frequent appearances on the Steve Allen show.

"The frantic physicist," as he was called in a recent article in Life magazine, has also appeared on the Jerry Lewis show and Panorama Pacific. In past summers, the new Professor Wonderful had a science series showing in Australia. On the Mickey Mouse Club,

Miller will utilize outdoor exhibits at Disneyland and indoor facilities of the "Mousekalab" of the Disney studios. His presentations will feature demonstrations in the understandable and often amusing manner which characterizes his performances, making learning sheer joy for the millions familiar with his individualistic techniques.

LIFE MAGAZINE states that "for 33 of his 54 years he has been on a one-man crusade to make everyone — young, old,

dumb or smart—love science." In the same article, Miller insists modestly, "I teach nothing. I merely try to fire up the imagination."

Miller's part in the show will consist of 5 to 9 minute segments, twice a week, and in between, a full schedule including appearances with Steve Allen, lecture dates, and classes at El Camino College.

Miller has already concluded 38 taping sessions for the new Disney presentations. He will be among the "un-mouset" characters to take a place on the club roster.
