

EC Nine Snaps Losing Skein

That "shadow of defeat" which has hung over the El Camino College baseball team for almost 22 weeks cast itself away Saturday as the Warriors proved once and for all, they're not "that bad."

The Warriors, whose team play has been as freakish as a thermometer, jumping from hot to cold, waited until the last day of the season to beat East Los Angeles twice, 11-6 and 8-7, and escape the Metropolitan Conference cellar.

At the same time, El Camino thrust the Huskies into the backseat in the standings. By winning, the Warriors finished the season 7-14 while the double loss put East Los Angeles one full game behind, 6-15.

The Warriors had gone into the final day's action a game in the cellar. This following Friday's 9-7 defeat at the hands of Bakersfield, coupled with ELA's surprise 18-11 win over Long Beach.

At the beginning of the season, 22 weeks ago, El Camino was the choice to grab the flag. They started out to do just that.

Chuck Freeman's hopeful talent won four in a row to lead the league in almost all categories, including pitching, hitting and defense.
