### New Airport Reading Room To Be Opened

A new feature of interest for quiet rest and study—will be available to the public at the Los Angeles International Airport on Sunday.

It is located on the mezzanine level of the United Air Lines Satellite Building Number Seven where open house will be held from 1 p.m. to 8 p.m. It will be open to the public 24 hours daily.

**THIS IS** the new Christian Science Reading Room maintained by Christian Science churches and societies in the Greater Los Angeles area. It is the third such reading room in the United States according to William H. Waite, Christian Science Committee on Publication for Southern California.

The Reading Room, featuring walls of gray tones blending to the back wall of a deeper shade, was designed to give a feeling of rest and comfort. Beige carpeting and furniture of antique bronze finish, upholstered in terra cotta, lend a pleasing contrast to the interior decor.

The exterior walls are of glass mosaic veneer in gray tones. A show-case type display window curves to follow the lines of the Satellite Building's near-by rotunda.

## Riviera Methodists Plan Eighth Anniversary Fete

As the Riviera Methodist Church completes its eight year, activity is underway to launch Phase II of its growth and expansion. On May 31 members and friends of the church, located in the Hollywood Riviera section of Torrance, will celebrate the completion of mortgage payments on the present structures. This occasion will also mark the launching of a \$150,000, three-year building fund crusade coupled with an annual operations budget of \$58,437.

The Rev. Bill Usher, of the Southern California-Arizona Methodist Conference Board of Missions, is director of the stewardship crusade and will lead about 300 members of the church in their efforts to reach these goals. Church member Ivan Bowman is general chairman of the crusade assisted by the following chairmen: spiritual life, Mrs. Earl Olson; publicity, Howard Sosbee; visitation, Linden Hill; advanced gifts, Sturgis Stentz and William Pettepiece; arrangements, Mrs. Fred Peak; and clerical assistance, Mrs. Clifton Davis.

day Church Schools. Its ministry includes, in addition, two youth groups, six choirs, a women's organization with four circles, a men's club, a group for older members, one for single young adults and a couples' club. One of the outstanding activities of the church is a chancel drama group, The Wesley Players. The regular pot-luck supper Family Night is a favorite activity in this church with a very large proportion of young family members.

**THE CURRENT** facilities are offered to many community groups without cost as a community service. Presently a wide variety of regular and occasional users of the building include, Girl Scout troops and leadership training sessions, first-aid courses, instruction sessions for expectant mothers, YMCA units, Delphians, a needle worker's group, a TOPS club, and local churches presently without adequate facilities for certain functions.

The Riviera Methodist Church serves the communities of Redondo Beach, Torrance, Palos Verdes Estates, Rolling Hills Estates, City of Rolling Hills, and the unincorporated areas of the Palos Verdes Peninsula. Its members also come from El Segundo, Manhattan, and Hermosa Beach, Gardena, Hawthorne, Lomita, and San Pedro. In view of the unlikelihood of many more churches being built in this Riviera-Peninsula area due to lack of sites and high land costs, the building

committee of the Riviera church envisions a structure to meet increasing demands for an adequate Christian ministry to the community.

**WHILE THE** congregation currently represents approximately only half of its potential growth, it will dedicate itself to this initial step of Phase II to provide facilities for its ultimate constituency. The size and location of the present site at 375 Palos Verdes Blvd. makes it impractical to erect a building in stages.

Phase II visualizes the accomplishment of a master plan for full use of the available area in the present site. With adequate support for this challenge by members and friends, the Building Committee hopes to complete its program for church services on Easter 1966. The architectural firm, Killingsworth, Brady and Associate of Long Beach is engaged in the development of the master plan and the design of the building.
