



### Picturephone System Is Ready for Market Trial

Picturephones which allow a caller to see as he talks have been added to the Bell Telephone exhibit at Disneyland. The new service was first demonstrated on a coast-to-coast basis about three weeks ago when newsmen and Pacific Telephone officials gathered to talk and see by regular long distance telephone lines. Questions about the first picturephone were answered by a Bell Telephone engineer at an exhibit at the New York World's Fair. The new picturephone has a good quality picture, and for the first time appears economically feasible. The new telephone idea is still undergoing tests, but the system will be offered for a trial basis within a few months, report officials of the Bell system.

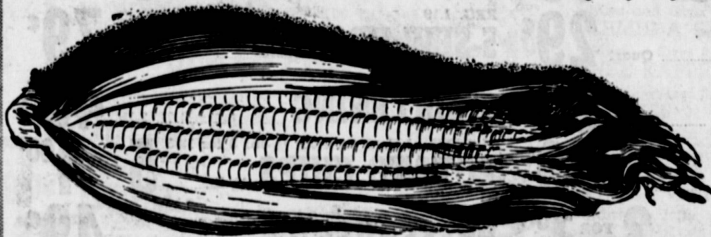
