### R. A. Watt Constructs Balanced Power Entry

"The Hillhaven," a 2,741 square foot, tri-level home, will be the Balanced-Power entry in the Los Angeles Home Show June 11 to 21.

Construction of Hillhaven will mark the fifth time a home for the event has been built by R. A. Watt, according to officials of Southern California Counties Gas Companies, sponsors of the entry.

Scheduled for entry at the Los Angeles Sports Arena during the Home Show's 11-day run, the tri-level home was designed by Phil Blair, AIBD,

member of R. A. Watt organization.

Built around a large garden court, Hillhaven includes four luxury bedrooms and a large rumpus-room. The adaptable floor plan was designed to provide changeability by growing families.

A highlight of the home is a dramatic entryway, which overlooks the garden court and doubles as a separation for the three family living areas.

The entire home is completely equipped with gas air conditioning for year around climate control.

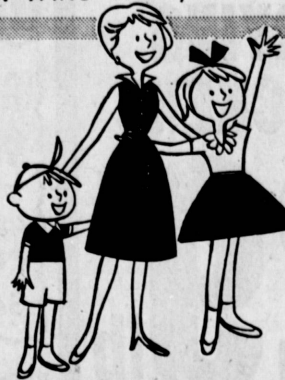
