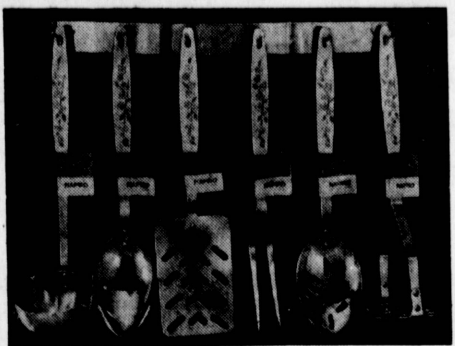

**Area Students Cited at Commerce Science Fair**

Local students participating in the annual City of Commerce California Science Fair have won several medals for their exhibits, reports Maurice H. Quigley, mayor of Commerce and chairman of the fair.

The students received the awards at a banquet at the Commerce auditorium. Dr. Willard Libby, Nobel prize winner from the University of California at Los Angeles, was the speaker.

Dominick DeLuca, 17, won a medal for his project on gas bacterial metabolism. DeLuca, a North High student, is the son of Anthony DeLuca of 16630 Haas Ave.

**NICHOLAS A. GREGORY**, son of Nicholas S. Gregory of 309 Via Linda Vista, won a medal for his studies in the light and early dark phases of photosynthesis. Gregory, who is 15, attends South High.

Also honored at the Science Fair was Tom Gulick, a senior

at Bishop Montgomery High School. Gulick's award was for an article explaining crystallography—a chemistry class project in growing crystals. Gulick won fourth prize in the writing contest.

Top winners at the fair received U.S. Savings Bonds presented by the City of Commerce, the Industrial Council of Commerce, and the Southern California Industry Education Council.

"Night of Royal Enchantment" has been selected as the theme for Carson High School's first senior prom, to be held tomorrow evening in the multipurpose room on campus.

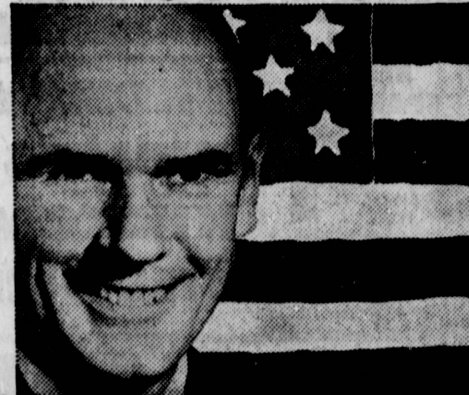
Guy Williams and a six-piece band will provide the music for the dance. A large crowd of seniors and their dates are expected to attend the first prom, which begins at 8 o'clock.
