Eight films including "The Red Balloon" and "Madeline" will be shown at the Torrance Library, 1345 Post Ave., on four Saturday mornings during the summer, it was announced yesterday by Mrs. Lila Held, children's librarian.

The schedule will open on Saturday morning, June 6, with the 10:30 showing of "Museum Man" and "Camel that Took a Walk"

"The Red Balloon" will be offered at 10:30 am. on Saturday, July 11. It will be the only film offered on that day.

Three films have been scheduled for Aug. 1. Show will be "The Tree," "Beaver Dam," and "Madeline."

The Aug. 29 shows, which wind up the summer program, will include "Fun Factory," and "Stars and Stripes."

No charge is made for admission to the Saturday morning shows, Mrs. Held emphasized.

California's Constitution Needs Fixing

To effect economies in government there is immediate need for revision of the California Constitution, according to Republican Assembly candidate Elizabeth (Liz) Jones. She added that a number of state agencies are frozen into the Constitution by outmoded laws. These agencies often have overlapping functions, but can't be touched without amending the Constitution.

The candidate indicated she favored a concise state constitution that would define the areas of responsibility between the three main branches of government—executive, legislative, and judicial.
