

Golf Business Booming, Bank Survey Indicates

"More golf balls dotted the fairways of America's 7,477 golf courses in 1963 than ever before," says the bank's periodical Small Business Report-

Approximately 6¼ million golfers played 15 or more rounds during the year, representing a 12 per cent increase over the previous year.

The golf business is booming, according to a report published today by Bank of American business.

OVER \$50 MILLION a year will be invested in golf links to meet the mounting demand, the bank study says. "In California, an expanding

population is clamoring for more golf facilities" the report declares. The state has 17.3 "waiting hours" either in the pro shop or coffee shop or on ing population — but only 6.4 per cent of its golf courses.

ON THE marketing side, the

report describes the average golfer as a man who will drive 45 minutes to get to a golf course-but no more. He is
