Teens Club Slates Car Wash Here

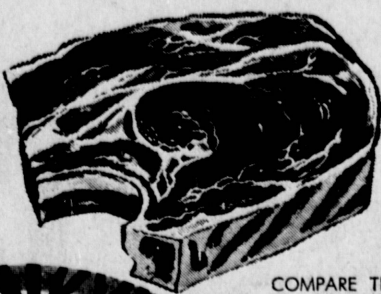
