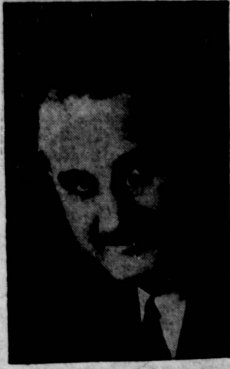


El Camino To Confer 600 Degrees
