

## Holy Love Can Alter World, Priest Says

Holy fear and holy love of the name of Jesus Christ can accomplish a four-fold task for mankind, worshippers at St. Andrew's Episcopal Church, 1432 Engracia Ave., were told Sunday.

Speaking was the Rev. Robert T. Stellar, executive secretary of the department of Christian Social Relations for the Los Angeles Episcopal Diocese.

"Holy fear and Holy Love of the name of Jesus Christ can break down sin, quicken man's sense of responsibility for his brothers, can utterly change the life of man, and can revolutionize the world," Father Stellar said.

SUCH HOLY FEAR and holy love can break down sin, bringing bitter enemies side by side to worship God, the priest said.

Speaking on the sense of responsibility, Father Stellar cited the story of Job, relating it to today's problems.

"In our highly complex society, it is easy for us to expect county welfare programs and charitable organizations to care for the poor," he said.

"But if we don't share in this help, we are missing our calling in Christ. Let no claim of thy neighbor on you find you cold," he warned.
