Hospital to Install New Board Panel

Road Project Approved by Supervisors

Major improvement of a portion of Crenshaw Boulevard in the Rolling Hills Estates area has been authorized under a joint program by the county and City of Rolling Hills Estates.

The proposed project, extending along Crenshaw from Palos Verdes Drive North to the north boundary of Rolling Hills Estates, will include reconstructing and widening the roadway to master plan highway width, with curbs, gutters and traffic signals.

The Board of Supervisors also allocated \$9,000 for improvement of Palos Verdes Drive East near Sunnyside Ridge Road.
