Jehovah's Witnesses Told Of 'Urgency of the Times'

"Facing up to the urgency of our times" was the theme of the main address delivered to more than 2,100 Jehovah's Witnesses at the Redondo Union High School assembly of the group last weekend.
The group heard the speaker cite five reasons for the urgency, including the "pressure of worldwide immorality, materialism filling the minds of people, national disturbances around the globe, and fear of nuclear war." The speaker also said "this generation is on the verge of Armagedden, called 'The Great Day of God Almighty'."
"To face up to these urgent times," Jaracz said, "a person must draw strength and guidance from a source outside of himself. That source is Jehovah God."
Leonard Olliff, presiding minister of the Torrance Congregation of Jehovah's Witnesses, said 36 persons were baptized at the conclusion of the three-day assembly.
