

# Two Local Youths in Battle of The Bands

Hollywood Bowl debuts for Torrance youths Greg Bouette and Bill Robertson are set at Friday night's Battle of the Bands.

This annual teen music fest begins at 8:30 p.m. in the 18,000-seat starlight amphitheatre.

Bouette and Robertson will appear with Trombones Limited, an entry in the combo section of the contest.

Spotlighted in the 1964 Battle of the Bands will be 129 contestants, 101 production singers and 68 production dancers.

Contestants vie in five divisions, including dance bands, school bands, combos and solo and groups with vocalists. Combos and bands will also "battle" for a Sweepstakes Trophy for overall honors.

JERRY DEXTER, KLAC disc jockey, will emcee the program, and jazz star Pete Rugolo will be guest conductor. Rugolo will lead the production band in a special medley of his television themes, including "Dr. Kildare," "The Fugitive" and others.

Judges include arranger-composer Neal Hefti, band leader Gerald Wilson, jazz trumpet player Pete Candoli, singer-arranger-composer Alan Copeland and Leonard Feather, author of "The Encyclopedia of Jazz."

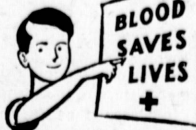

HIGHLIGHTS OF the program will be telecast on KTLA next week. Competition in this contest began with February auditions, more than 1,000 Southland teenagers sought Bowl berths.

The Battle of the Bands, sponsored by County Parks and Recreation, began in East Los Angeles in 1954. This is the fifth presentation at the Hollywood Bowl.
