Agreements with local school districts to provide recreation programs on school grounds during the summer were approved this week by the County, reports Supervisor Kenneth Hahn.

The County Parks and Recreation Department will sponsor and provide personnel for recreation programs in schools within unincorporated territory so local youngsters may enjoy the playgrounds while school is not normally in session.

Supervisor Hahn initiated this program several years ago after noting "it was not fair to the children to lock the school yards for three months each year and let them sit idle."
