

### Vets May Qualify

Retired or unemployed veterans over the age of 65 who have a disability rating of 10 per cent or more may be eligible for non-service connected pensions, Supervisor Burton W. Chace announced.

Supervisor Chace said vets with limited incomes who served at least 90 days in war time may get full information from Los Angeles County Service Officer Arthur H. Tryon.
