

Garrett Promotes Two Men

Promotion of G. D. "Jerry" Bradley to vice president, industrial relations, and Carl F. Fisher to treasurer has been announced by Harry Wetzel, president of The Garrett Corp.

Bradley replaces C. W. Reynolds, who retired June 30, while Fisher assumes the duties of Theodore G. Hawkins, who also retired June 30. Reynolds worked for the firm for 22 years, and Hawkins retired with 13 years of service.

Bradley, an employee of the firm since 1941, has worked with personnel and industrial relations problems for the past 23 years. He is a member of the President's Co-

BORN IN Jackson, Ohio, on April 26, 1907, Rice attended North High School in Columbus, Ohio, and graduated from Ohio State University with a bachelor's degree in mechanical engineering in 1929.

After graduation, he began his career in Trenton, N.J., with the former American Steel and Wire Division. Advancing through the ranks, he became department foreman and, in 1940, was transferred to San Francisco where he became superintendent of the wire rope mill, he was promoted to the position of works engineer in 1944.

Three years later, Rice was named division superintendent of the sheet and tin mill at the Pittsburg Works and later became assistant general superintendent. He was named general superintendent of Torrance Works in 1952 and, in 1954, was transferred back to Pittsburg Works as general superintendent. He became general manager - operations in the San Francisco office of Columbia-Geneva in 1957 and was named vice president-operations in 1959.
