A young group of Torrance entertainers who call themselves The Pharoahs have received letters of appreciation for their part in the California visit of President Lyndon Johnson and Judge Evelle Younger's campaign for district attorney.

The group includes Ernie Hernandez, his brother Richard, Lindy Nuzzo, all of Torrance, and drummer Barry Carter of Palos Verdes. Yolanda Hernandez is the vocalist.

The Pharoahs had to undergo a strict security clearance by the Secret Service before their appearance before the President at the Hollywood Paladium.

The group also played during the campaign Judge Younger conducted for district attorney. Judge Younger, in a letter to the group, said he had heard many "wonderful comments on your appearance," he added, "I'm very proud to have you all on my team."

The letter from the President, will be framed in gold from the mines of the pyramids in Egypt.

The letter read in part, "This is to express the President's thanks to you and the young people you represent for the plaque and ball that he received during his California visit. He appreciated these gifts, and was equally pleased by the enthusiastic welcome given him and his party by 'The Pharoahs'."

Red Cross, United Way Will Merge

United Way, Inc., and 13 chapters of the American National Red Cross in Los Angeles County have announced a new fund-raising partnership.

Supervisor Checks U.S. Parks, Says Southland Beats Them All

In some states, Hahn said, an area is considered a park when it is little more than an open field. "Because few recreational activities are offered there, it stands to reason use of the park is slight," he said.
