Every homemaker is interested will look best. However, when there is a serious seeing job to be done, lamps should be no more than 24 to 30 inches from your work for best lighting results. Don't place a table lamp, for instance, in the center of a large table and then expect it to light a chair located several feet away. Many of our modern lamps, especially CLM which give guaran-teed amounts of light, are carefully designed for top lighting performance only when properly placed.
