


#### Parade Set As Dennee Goes To White House

It's not the circus but it will be the nearest thing to it this side of fabulous Fifth Ave. That's the promise from Lloyd Dennee this week as hectic preparations were completed for the largest and most

entertaining parade ever seen on the streets of Hawthorne. Movie, radio and television stars, three prize-winning marching bands, gorgeous cover girls and tournament queens galore are all included in the 55-unit parade scheduled for

10:30 Saturday morning. The parade will be the opening gun in day-long festivities planned to celebrate the opening of Dennee's new appliance center, The White House.

Reasons for the circulation locally of the petitions, it is pointed out, is that the Board of Supervisors proposes to build a Superior Court Building in the area bounded by Temple Street, North Hill street, the Freeway and North Grand Avenue, at a cost of nearly eleven million dollars; to lease and later buy, a Municipal Court Building at a cost of more than five million dollars. The Law Library Trustees propose to build a County Law Library Building of land purchased by the County at a probable minimum cost of one and onehalf million dollars.
