Adults Play In Volley Ball Tournaments

A series of volley ball tournaments for men and women in the free adult class at the Torrance Evening High School, meeting on Tuesday and Thursday nights, was announced by Coach Cliff Gravbehl.

As part of the Physical Fitness Program, open to all adults, regardless of residence, three types of volley ball tournaments will be held: (1) "Triples" tournament (women), (2) "Triples" tournament (men), (3) Fourperson mixed teams. These tournaments will be the double elimination type.

Instruction on court play and basic skills will be stressed for beginning students. Advanced students will be given new techniques to further increase their skill.

As part of this Physical Fitness course, it is planned that a womens calisthenics session will be set up to serve as a general body-toner, weight-reducer and physical fitness device.

Men and women are invited to join this free group to receive instruction in volley ball, enter the volley ball tournament, or calisthenics, or any other phase of this Physical Fitness Program. They should go directly to the Torrance High School Gym to register on Tuesday night, January 2, at 7 o'clock.

The three free adult dressmaking classes are: Monday mornings from 9 to 12 at the Walteria Recreation Hall, Monday and Wednesday evenings at the Torrance Evening High school, and Tuesday and Thursday evenings at the Torrance Evening High school. All classes are free and open to all adults, regardof residence. Students should go directly to class to register. Students are requested to bring their own materials, old clothing, patterns or ideas for clothing requirements for all members of their family. Those who have never done any sewing and those who are quite advanced will all profit from the instruction, because the class is held essentially on an individual basis.


