Dominguez channel from its source at the Los Angeles International Airport to its outlet into the Los Angeles harbor at Henry Ford avenue is the main drainage outlet for Gardena Valley. There is a natural depression known as Johnson lake, lying north of Rosecrans avenue, and east of Crenshaw boulevard, and a second natural depression known as Laguna Dominguez near Avalon boulevard and Carson street north of Wilmington, Many years ago a partial capacity channel was excavated to connect Johnson lake with Laguna Dominguez and a partial capacity outlet excavated from Loguna Dominguez to the Los Angeles harbor.

Under existing conditions these two basins act as storage reservoirs during a major storm and the height to which water will rise in these basins has been determined on the basis fo present channel capacities. Marginal development of these basins has been predicated on this maximum water surface. This system is now in a state of balance and any channel enlargement below Johnson lake must start at the ocean outlet and progress

upstream. It has always been the policy of this district to expend its funds to provide for the greatest possible degree of flod protection with a minimum expenditure of funds. Since the covered channel costs from two to three times as much as an open channel, without any increase in carrying capacity, this type of channel is constructed only when necessary to locate it in a street, or under other very exceptional conditions where its cost is equal to or less than the open channel.
