May Bring Wasp From India

Two parasitic wasps from India are being studied by the University of California College of Agriculture as a possible biological control of olive scale. A few of the wasps have recently been released in the Fresno area.

Alfred M. Boyce, professor of entomology, Citrus Experiment Station, Riverside, has been collecting parasites of the olive scale in India, Afghanistan, and

Pakistan. He is now in Africa. Richard L. Doutt, assistant professor of biological control, is in charge of rearing these parasites for release in the field. One, an Aphytis, lays its eggs on the surface of the scale. When the eggs hatch the larvae devour the scale. The adult females also kill some scales by feeding. The other, an Habrolepis, lays its eggs inside the body of the scale.
