Emphasizing this year's slogan, "Your Gift Is Important," the chairman said that "through the American National Red Cross and its volunteer workers, your wish to help your neighbors near and far and the fighting man in Korea can be expressed. Now that flood victims across town and that wounded G. I. in Korea are right next door — you have but to put your hand in your pocket or roll up your sleeve and you can serve that neighbor, even though you don't know his name."
