Big Fund Loss Told as Court Goes to Redondo

The City of Torrance will be out several thousand dollars after January 1, when the inferior courts reorganization bill goes into effect, City Manager George Stevens announced this

The district municipal court at Redondo Beach, which will replace our city court, will mean a considerable cut in revenue from

fines, Stevens said. The cost of transporting prisoners from Torrance to Redondo Beach will be offset by funds allocated back here. The allocated funds are no where equal to income from Torrance City Court,

Stevens pointed out. To what extent the income cut will affect the 1952-53 year finances is being determined now by Stevens as he begins prepara tion of the city's budget.
