On the Democratic ballot, there are two delegations, one announced for Senator Estes Ke-fauver, and the other an un-instructed delegation headed by At-torney General Edmund G. (Pat) Brown.

Assemblyman Vincent Thomas is unopposed for reelection as Assemblyman from the 68th As-sembly District.

Other party offices to be vot-ed on are members of the Coun-ty Central Committee of the var-ious parties.

COUNTY OFFICES County and judicial offices to be filled are holding much inter-est here.

Harold Harby, currently a member of the Los Angeles City Council, is making an impres-sive bid for election to the office of County Supervisor for the 4th District, now held by Raymond V. Darby, a candidate to succeed himself. He is opposed by: Glenn Anderson, Los Angeles; Gray-don F. Beeks, Rolling Hills; Leonard J. McMullen, Los An-geles; Ernest A. Stewart, Her-mosa Beach; and Kirk White, Manhattan Beach.

Another election holding prin-cipal interest is that of Judge of the new South Bay Municipal Court to serve Torrance and the South Bay area cities and ter-ritory.

Walter N. Anderson of Man-hattan Beach is giving Justice of the Peace John A. Shidler stiff competition for office No. 1.

Judge D. Clifford Higgins of Manhattan Beach, is putting up a fighting race for election to office No. 2. Others running are Judge Otto B. Willett, Torrance, and Collamer A. Bridge, Hermosa Beach.

Judge Shidler's race will be de-cided on June 3, but there may be a runoff if no candidate for office No. 2 gets a majority of all votes cast.

NEW COURT The local Justice court and all City courts will be eliminated on January 2, 1953, when the new South Bay Municipal Court is officially established.

For office of District Attorney, the incumbent, S. Ernest Roll, of Los Angeles, is being opposed by Claude A. Watson, also of Los Angeles.
