Over one hundred guests witnessed the double ring ceremony officiated by Father Robert Young.

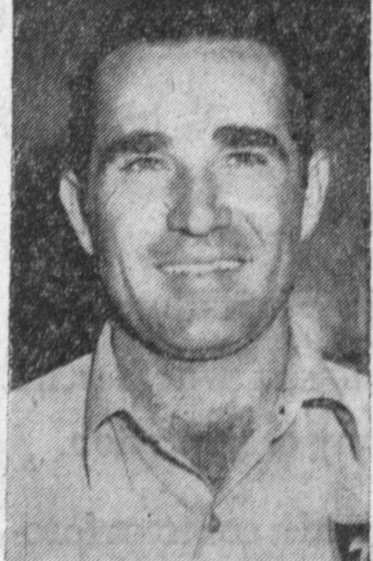
