Here's Hot Sandwich for Snack Serving

Broiled liver sausage sandwiches—prepare them for a special Sunday night supper or snack. They require little preparation because they're made with this ready-to-serve meat.

According to Reba Staggs, home economist, to make the sandwich, use a fork to mash one pound of liver sausage into a spreading consistency. Moisten the meat with 1/4 cup of prepared mustard and season with 1/2 cup of grated onion. In the meantime, toast bread slices on one side. Turn and spread them with the liver sausage mixture. Place the open-faced sandwiches on your broiler rack about 2 inches from the heat. Broil until the spread is heated through, then serve immediately. With one pound of liver sausage you'll get from 10 to 12 servings.

Here's another hot sandwich idea—bacon and baked beans. For this sandwich, toast slices of bread on one side, then turn and top with baked beans moistened with catsup. Place short strips of bacon over the beans and broil at a moderate temperature until the bacon is crisp.

Here's Tempting Casserole with Chipped Beef

Here's a handy combination you will turn to time and again. It's handy because it is prepared with chipped beef from your kitchen shelf. According to Reba Staggs, home economist, this is a dish you'll find appropriate for guest serving too.

Creamed Chipped Beef—Curried

1/2 pound chipped beef
6 tablespoons flour
1/4 cup butter or margarine
3 cups milk

Curried Rice Ring

Shred beef. Melt butter or margarine and add beef, stirring occasionally until browned and crisp. Add flour and mix well. Add milk gradually, stirring constantly until thickened. Boil 3 minutes. Serve in a ring of curried rice. 6 servings.

Curried Rice Ring

1 1/2 cups rice
1 tablespoon curry powder
1 tablespoon salt
3 quarts boiling water
1/4 cup melted butter or margarine

Wash rice. Drain. Add curry powder and salt to boiling water. Add rice and boil rapidly 15 to 25 minutes. Turn into sieve and rinse with hot water.

To make a rice ring, add 1/4 cup melted butter to cooked rice and pack in a well-greased 8-inch ring mold. Let stand a few minutes. Unmold the ring onto a large platter and fill with cream chipped beef.

Meat Sauce News—Heart 'Italienne'

If meat sauce with spaghetti is a favorite dish at your house, here is a tempting variation—Heart 'Italienne'. Beef or veal heart is cut into cubes, then simmered with the same ingredients as your usual meat sauce. It, too, may be served over cooked spaghetti.

Heart 'Italienne'

2 pounds beef or veal heart
3 tablespoons lard or dripping
1/2 cup onion, chopped
1 clove garlic, chopped
1 teaspoon salt
1/2 teaspoon pepper
2 tablespoons pimiento, chopped
1 small can tomato paste
1 No. 2 1/2 can tomatoes
1 8-ounce package spaghetti, cooked
1/2 cup grated cheddar cheese

Wash hearts thoroughly, remove veins and hard parts and cut meat in 1-inch cubes. Brown meat, garlic and onion in lard or drippings. Add salt, pepper, pimiento, tomatoes, tomato paste and simmer two hours, or until meat is tender and mixture thickened. Serve over spaghetti and top with grated cheese. 6 to 8 servings.
