Local Chamber Fights Slough Oil Drilling

Officials of the Harbor City Chamber of Commerce went on record recently as opposed to the establishment of an 80-acre oil-drilling district in the Bixby Slough area this week.

In a letter to the Los Angeles city planning commissioners the officials stated that they were opposed on the grounds that the area comprised the only region in which the city could expand. They said oil drilling would slow the expansion.

City planners currently have under consideration a drilling application by the Lebo-McNeil Co. and will announce their decision today.

At a recent hearing before the planners, Harbor City owners of property in the proposed oil-drilling district appeared to voice opposition to the granting of the application.


Among those opposing the proposal were Mrs. Alta Collins and representatives of the Malleable Fittings Corp. and the Foursquare Church.

The district is bounded by 123rd St. on the north, Pacific Coast Hwy. on the south, Vermont Ave.

Improvements Scheduled for Hospital Here

Improvements in the amount of \$95,779 are planned at Harbor General Hospital during the current fiscal year, county officials revealed today.

Biggest single item is \$15,943 for purchase and installation of surgical equipment at the ear, nose and throat clinic. Also allocated is \$3700 for improvement of the clinic building.

Another large item is \$15,750 for fire resistant plastering of the hospital boiler room, a badly needed safety factor since the room is located in the center of the hospital.

Other expenditures include funds for additional parking space, sidewalks, medical staff offices, surgery service addition, X-ray room improvements and other projects designed to increase the hospital's efficiency.

Quoting statistics of the National Association of Manufacturers, a figures expert, Daniel M. Maher, chief cost accountant of the Dresser Equipment Co. of Torrance, says the proposed 1953 budget of President Truman will cost the average family \$126 a month in direct and concealed taxes.—Los Angeles, Calif., Times.
