

### Rev. Kenneth Knox Appointed to Head Wayfarers' Chapel

Appointment of the Rev. Kenneth Knox, a recent graduate of the Church of the New Jerusalem seminary in Cambridge, Mass., as pastor of Wayfarers' Chapel, was announced today by New Church officials.

The Rev. Knox succeeds the Rev. Andrew Diaconoff, minister of the New Church in Los Angeles, who had been acting as temporary pastor of the unique glass and redwood church on the Palos Verdes peninsula.

The Rev. Knox announced that for the time being Wayfarers' Chapel hours and services will remain unchanged. The chapel will be open daily for tourists making the peninsula drive. The Sunday morning service will be held at 11 o'clock weekly with Sunday afternoon vesper services continuing to begin at 4:30 o'clock.
