On July 8 the City of Torrance passed Ordinance 603 which requires residences to possess an incinerator which has the following features:

A metal grate for ashes.

An opening with a removable cover for taking out the ashes.

A permanently attached door which closes automatically when not held open.

A spark arrestor to keep hot ashes from flying around the neighborhood.

Barbecue Pits may not be used as incinerators.

Violation of any provision of the ordinance is punishable by a \$300 fine, six months in jail, or both.


